Registered Care

Heights Kindergarten is a Registered Care provider with the Family Assistance Office and therefore a Child Care Benefit is payable to eligible parents. To be eligible to receive a Registered Care payment, a parent must satisfy the work test set by the Family Assistance Office (ph 13 61 50) and lodge a claim form with the Family Assistance Office. Forms can also be obtained from our Business Office. All communication regarding payment of this benefit is with the FAO.

Heights Kindergarten is an approved Kindergarten Program with the Queensland Government. You may be eligible for reduced Kindergarten fees upon the presentation of a valid Health Care Card to our Business Office in January each year. Heights Kindergarten will pass on the government Health Care Card Subsidy in October each year, once Kindergarten funding has been finalised by the State Government.
