



ACCOMMODATION AND WELFARE POLICY

All overseas students attending Heights College under the age of 18 years will live with a parent or relative, as permitted by the Department of Immigration. The student's family must provide proof of the relationship to the Department of Immigration at the time of visa application.

The College does not approve any other accommodation options for overseas students, including homestays or specific requests from parents for their children to live with friends or other family members.

This policy also applies to students who turn 18 during their enrolment at the College.

As part of their visa conditions, all parents on behalf of students are required to notify the College of a change of address while enrolled in the course.

The student will live with a parent or relative as permitted by the Department of Immigration.

- In this case the College does not provide a welfare letter (CAAW) via PRISMS. The student's family provides proof of relationship to Department of Immigration for the purposes of visa application.
